White Chocolate and Raspberry Cheesecake Ingredients

185 g sweet plain biscuits crushed

90g butter, melted

500g cream cheese, softened

395g sweetened condensed milk

100g Baking White Chocolate Block

1 tbs gelatine powder

1/4 cup hot water

3/4 cup cream

150g fresh raspberries, pureed

METHOD

Sprinkle gelatine over hot water, stir to dissolve and allow to cool.

Combine biscuits and butter, then press into the base of a 23cm springform pan and refrigerate until firm. Beat cream cheese and sweetened condensed milk together until smooth and then beat in ice cream. Melt white cooking chocolate and then allow to cool. Beat cooled chocolate and gelatine into cream cheese mixture and then spoon evenly over crumb base. Swirl raspberry puree through the cheesecake mixture. If desired melt more white chocolate and drizzle over top.

Berry Christmas

Summer berry pavlova

Sometimes you can't beat a classic. With this recipe you can substitute making the meringue base with a store bought pavlova.

Ingredients

MERINGUE

6 large free-range egg whites 300 g caster sugar

PAVLOVA

400 g fresh strawberries and raspberries

200 ml double cream

200 ml fat-free natural yoghurt

2 tablespoons caster sugar

1 vanilla pod

a few sprigs of fresh mint

METHOD

Preheat the oven to 150°C/300°F/gas 2. Put your egg whites into a clean bowl and whisk them at a medium speed until they start to form nice firm peaks.

With your mixer still running, gradually add the sugar and a pinch of sea salt. Turn the mixer up to the highest setting and whisk for 7 to 8 minutes more until the meringue is white, glossy and smooth. If it feels grainy, whisk for a little bit longer, being careful not to let the meringue collapse.


Line two baking trays with baking paper. Divide the meringue mixture evenly between them and shape each blob into a circle about 20cm in diameter. Put both trays into the oven and bake for 1 hour until the meringues look slightly golden and are fluffy in the middle.

Halve or quarter the large strawberries and leave the smaller ones whole. Mix them with the raspberries. Whip the cream with the sugar until it forms soft peaks, then stir in the yoghurt. Halve the vanilla pod lengthways, scrape out the seeds and fold them into the creamy mixture.

Spoon half the cream mixture on top of one of the meringue halves and smooth it out. Sprinkle half of your berries evenly around the cream mixture. Place the other meringue on top and press down gently to stick them together.

Spread the remaining cream mixture over the top layer and sprinkle the remaining berries on top. Pick a few small mint leaves, scatter over and en-

CONWAY WAIAU TB MANAGEMENT AREA POSSUM GROUND CONTROL - POISON WARNING

Vector Free Marlborough Limited wishes to advise that a ground-based possum control operation will be taking place to keep possum numbers under control to prevent the spread of bovine tuberculosis to livestock. It is important that we keep possum numbers low, as we work towards eradicating TB from New Zealand over the long term. This operation will be conducted as a part of OSPRI's TBfree programme.

Description of control area

Hanmer Basin: Located between the Hanmer Range and the Waiau River. The area includes the pastoral farmed flats south and west of Hanmer Springs township to the bush edge on the foothills at the base of the Hanmer Range.

A map of the area can be found on the Vector Free Marlborough website under the Current Operations tab

Operation date

20 September 2021 to 31 January 2022 (approximate)

Poisoning methods, poison used and nature of poison

• Feratox encapsulated cyanide in the form of a capsule, dyed green/blue, presented with feed-paste or similar attractant contained inside a reusable bait stations 130 cm above the ground.

General warning

The public are reminded of the danger that toxic baits and possum carcasses pose, particularly to children and dogs.

- Follow advice stated on poison warning signs
- Do not touch poison baits, bait stations or traps
- Do not touch poisoned possum carcasses
- Keep children under strict supervision in the control area
- Keep pets under supervision; do not let dogs eat poisoned carcasses

Warning signs will be erected at all main public entry points and the public are reminded that it is an offence to remove any of these signs. Please follow the instructions stated on the signs.

If you suspect poisoning

- National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON 0800 764 766
- In the case of a domestic animal being poisoned, contact a local veterinarian.



Hi everybody,

The silly season is rapidly approaching so here's a few reminders around keeping yourself and your belongings safe this summer.

Home security

As always, with the increase of visitors coming to enjoy what Hanmer has to offer over the summer months, we also see an increase of undesirables and associated crime. These individuals benefit from our complacency and some simple things go a long way to reducing your odds of becoming a victim. Secure your property while you're not there, including sheds and garages. Lock your vehicles overnight and consider installing security sensor lighting or CCTV cameras to discourage people coming onto your property for a snoop around. Report any suspicious activity to Police at the time of seeing it.

Community Crime Prevention Cameras - Additional sites

The Hanmer Springs Community Trust have secured sufficient funding for the addition of seven sites to the already established Hanmer Springs Crime Prevention Camera System. Work on the additions will begin early in the new year. Thanks to the Hanmer Springs Business community that donated funds towards the project, and a massive thanks to the Hanmer Springs Community Trust who worked tirelessly to secure the extra required funding. The system is an asset to the community and the additions will only improve what we already have. As always, if you have any questions or would like to discuss the system, feel free to contact either of us and we'll happily chat with you about it.

Pesky phone scams

Sadly, these seem to have become an everyday part of life. Recently a senior member of our community received a scamming phone call to their landline phone number. Fortunately, they had the good sense to identify it for what it was and terminated the call, however it does act as a timely reminder to us all. The simple advice is, if you receive a phone call that you believe to be a scam, just hang up. If the caller alleges to be from a service provider that you subscribe to (e.g. telco or utilities provider) terminate the call and phone that provider on their listed number (not the one that was used to phone you on). You'll quickly establish whether the company was attempting to contact you or whether the call you received was a scam.

The Netsafe website (netsafe.org.nz) is a fantastic resource and has a large amount of information and advice about what scams are doing the rounds and key things to look out for to identify a phone call as a scam. In the case above, simply pressing a number on their keypad could have resulted in them becoming a victim.

Lastly, getting hold of us has never been easier. If you can't track us down at the Police station, simply call 105 (the non-emergency number) and ask to speak to whoever is working in Hanmer. If we're not immediately available to take your call, we'll be notified and get back to you as soon as possible. As always, if it's an emergency and you need an immediate response, call 111.

Keep safe out there and have a Merry Christmas.



Kerbside refuse and recycling collection – Monday 8am

Only official refuse and recycling bags will be collected; these can be purchased from Hanmer Springs Service Station and the libraryand the Log Cabin & Super Liquor Via the recycling bags clean paper, card, cans and plastics types 1, 2 & 5 only can be recycled.

If in doubt – place it in the refuse to save contaminating recycling.

Non complying bags and recycling bags containing glass and soft plastics will not be collected.

Please Note that HDC garbage & recycling bags are no longer available from the Four Square supermarket . Henceforth, bags will only be available from Hanmer Springs Service Station, the library , The Log Cabin and Super Liquor



HANMER SPRINGS CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR REFUSE AND RECYCLING ARRANGEMENTS

Refuse and recycling collection days in Hanmer Springs will be changing over Christmas and New Year to the following days.

- Tuesday 28 December 2021
- Tuesday 4 January 2022

Please remember the following when using the Councils refuse and recycling collection service.

- Only Hurunui Council bags will be collected, these are available from various outlets in Hurunui.
- Bags must be securely tied and at the kerbside or council collection point by 8am. Collection times may vary to normal, and the crew will not return to collect bags placed out late.
- Refuse bags must not exceed 15kg in weight. Bags split prior to the crew's arrival and non-official bags will not be collected.
- Bundles of cardboard will not be collected but can be recycled via any transfer station.

What is accepted via the recycling collections if it is clean and loose in a Council recycling bag?

- Newspapers, magazines, office paper and telephone directories.
- Cardboard, greetings cards, junk mail, envelopes, and egg boxes.
- Food, drink, and pet food cans.
- Rigid plastic bottles and small containers, types 1, 2 and 5 with lids removed.

What cannot be recycled?

Soft plastics, plastics 3, 4, 6 and 7, tetrapaks, polystyrene (including meat trays), plant pots, plastic strapping, clothing, food-stained paper or card, coffee cups, plastic lids, foil trays and food waste are not recyclable - if in doubt throw it out.

Glass Bottle Recycling

Do not put glass bottles in recycling bags, these can be recycled via any transfer station. In Hanmer Springs, providing households use an official Council glass recycling box they will be collected.
