

# ROASTED KUMARA WITH TAMARIND, PEANUT AND LIME

Crazy Kiwi cousin of the baked potato.

**INGREDIENTS** 

1kg small/medium kumaras

olive oil

Tamarind dressing

30g tamarind paste

10g (2 tsp) honey

2g (1/2 tsp) ground cumin

pinch of cayenne

juice of ½ lime

uice oi /2 iiiii

Salad

60g peanuts (or swap for cashews, if allergic)

70g (about ½) cucumber, semi-peeled and diced

70g (3-4) radishes, diced

50g (about 1/4) red onion, diced

20g (about ½) chopped green jalapeno, optional

juice of ½ a lime

olive oil

To finish

3-4 tbsp tahini

11/2 tbsp honey

2 tsp zaatar (Use Thyme, oregano or marjoram)\*

handful of coriander leaves

#### **METHOD**

Preheat the oven to 160C fan-forced (180C conventional). Prick the sweet potatoes several times with a fork and rub them with a little olive oil and salt. Place them on a baking tray lined with baking paper and roast for 40-60 minutes, or until they are soft all the way through. While they are roasting, prepare your tamarind dressing and salad. For the dressing, combine all the ingredients in a small bowl and set aside.

For the salad, toast the nuts in the oven for 7-10 minutes, or until golden brown and fragrant, then add them to a mixing bowl. Add the cucumber, radish, onion and chopped jalapeno, the lime juice and olive oil and a good pinch of salt. Toss to combine and set aside. When the potatoes are completely soft, remove from the oven, place on a serving plate and cut a slit lengthwise through the centre. Squash the sweet potatoes to open them out, then drizzle with tahini and honey and add a good sprinkle of salt. Spoon the salad over the top then drizzle the dressing over everything. Finish with a sprinkle of zaatar and coriander leaves.

\*Zaatar is a middle east spice blend. To make your own blend thyme, oregano, some lightly toasted sesame seeds and a pinch of sea salt.

# HOT-SMOKED NZ SALMON WITH GREENS

Gourmet fast food INGREDIENTS

- •400g hot-smoked NZ salmon or smoked trout, skin on
- •250g small Brussels sprouts, halved lengthwise
- •250g green beans, topped not tailed
- •200g peas
- ·sea salt and cracked black pepper

#### Chive and lemon vinaigrette dressing

2 tbsp lemon juice

2 tbsp extra virgin olive oil

1 tbsp honey

½ tsp sea salt

pinch of cracked black pepper

1 tbsp snipped chives and/or dill

#### **METHOD**

- Heat the oven to 160C fan-forced (180C conventional). Place the fish (skin-side down) on an oven tray lined with baking paper, lightly cover with a square of aluminium foil and heat through for 10 minutes.
- To make the chive and lemon vinaigrette, whisk the lemon juice, oil, honey, salt and pepper together in a medium bowl. Add the snipped chives and dill, stir and set aside.
- Cook the Brussels sprouts and beans in simmering salted water for 3 minutes. Add the peas and bring back to the boil, then drain immediately.
- Toss the cooked and drained greens through the vinaigrette to coat, then place on a warm serving plate.
- To serve, remove the skin from the fish and scrape off any discoloured surface. Roughly break up the fish into bite-sized chunks with your hands and place it on top of the greens. Spoon over the chive and lemon vinaigrette and serve.



Accompanied by his tutor Baron, Reginald aged 16, who suffered from asthma, made the six month trip on the SS 'Medic", from his home in Truro, Cornwall, to New Zealand, specifically to take the waters at the Sanatorium, Hanmer Springs.

Monday, February 24, 1902

Baron was up early and packed our things but I stayed in bed a little later as I had been sick during the night. We all went to the station (Rangiora) together, but Mr and Mrs Peters left for the south before we started.

The first part of our journey was through the Plains but when we got among the hills the gradient became very stiff. We skirted the Great North Road for some of the way but left it in the hills. We had lunch at Culverden and then went on by coach. The road first skirts the hills and then plunges into them, following the Waiau in its course as far as the Hanmer Plains where it crosses the narrow gorge by a bridge 400 feet above the water. From the bridge it is 5 miles across the

plain to the Sanatorium. When we reached there we proceeded to remove the dust which had been pouring in on us in the coach, and had a good wash. At dinner we found that only three ladies, besides ourselves were staying in the first-class part. They were very jolly however and quite made up for the want of numbers.

Tuesday, February 25.

We had our first bathe this morning in the swimming pool which is 33 feet by twenty-eight, and very enjoyable it was. The water is buoyant and easy to swim in, and the taste is not as bad as seawater. In the afternoon we had another bathe, and after tea had a short walk with the ladies, Misses Bevan, Gifford and Filleul. The sunset tonight was very beautiful, as the sun set behind the hills, the colouring was very brilliant. The Hanmer Plains are surrounded by hills, and only accessible from the South by the way we came, Jollies and Jacks passes leading to the North through the mountains.

Wednesday, February 26.

After breakfast we climbed Majuba Hill, situated at the back of the township. We reached the summit 20 minutes after leaving the base. We lengthened the flagstaff and pulled up a cairn of stones. We came down to the Sanatorium direct and had a bathe before lunch. In the evening we visited two small sulphur springs, in the natural state, nearby.

Thursday, February 27.

A lazy day. That part of the time not occupied in bathing was passed in reading and resting. In the evening we all walked as far as Black Road, towards Jacks Pass. We were followed all the way by a black cat that was not in any way daunted by the streams we crossed. It even climbed the rock with us.

Friday, February 28.

We only had one bathe today and the afternoon was spent in resting. In the evening, Baron and I, with the others, had a walk to Dog Creek.

Saturday, March 1.

Miss Bevan left this morning and after seeing her off we took our bathe. After dinner, Dr Little, who I'd seen the night before about my face, and who had given me some ointment for it, took us for a drive to Jollies Pass where he went to see a patient.

We heard today of the fight the New Zealander's had been in and lost so heavily, in South Africa. It casts quite a gloom over the colony.


Sunday, March 2.

I spent the forenoon in reading as there was no morning service. In the afternoon I went to the Presbyterian Church and heard the Rev Campbell preach and again in the evening.

Monday, March 3.

We left by coach this morning and were sorry to leave the friends we had made there. The journey down was not nearly so dusty as when we came up. I had a box seat after leaving the Ferry, 5 miles from Hanmer. We had lunch at Culverden and after that I went to see Dr Little while Baron looked after our luggage. Dr Little gave me some more ointment, also a prescription for use at sea, and then came down to see us off. The journey to Rangiora was very tantalizing, the stops being so long and the train not going more than 20 miles an hour at the fastest.




