The centre reports that they are self isolating and doing well. To keep yourself well get your booster. **Wear a surgical or N95 mask, scan in, and show your vaccination pass when out and about.**

**Keep up healthy habits such as washing hands, physical distancing and staying home if you are sick.**

As Omicron cases rise, we all need to be prepared to self-isolate if you get COVID-19 or are a Household Contact.

## Grilled Salmon Fillet with Smoked Salmon and Dill Butter

The smoky-velvet taste lends a robust character, so little other embellishment is needed. Make the butter in advance and keep in the freezer, and you have an uncommonly elegant dinner in no time. It's great on most fish.

### INGREDIENTS

30-40 grams smoked salmon  
6 tablespoons unsalted butter at room temperature  
1 teaspoon lemon zest  
1 tablespoon minced fresh dill  
1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil  
750 grams salmon fillet with skin, in 4 equal pieces  
Salt and ground black pepper

### PREPARATION

Use a knife to mince smoked salmon. Place in a small bowl. Add butter and, with a fork, mash together until well combined. Add lemon zest and dill and mash in. Scoop butter onto a work surface, form into a cylinder about 2 inches in diameter, wrap in plastic and freeze. Have 4 dinner plates warming.

Heat a large heavy skillet, preferably cast iron, on medium-high. Add oil and brush to coat entire surface. Pat fish dry and place fillets, skin side down, in pan. Increase heat to high and cook about 3 minutes, until skin has browned. Turn the fillets and sear on high until flesh side has browned and is cooked to desired degree of doneness, another 2 to 3 minutes for medium to medium-rare.

While fish cooks, remove butter from freezer and slice into 4 patties. When fish is done, place a fillet, skin side down, on each dinner plate. Dust surface of fish with salt and pepper, place a portion of smoked salmon butter on top of each fillet and serve.



## Marinated Venison Steaks

When I was a child in Hanmer Springs, venison not a luxury, it was as common as beef or lamb and every household had their own way of cooking it. I discovered this recipe when I worked as a chef in the States. It was a thanksgiving Day special.

### INGREDIENTS

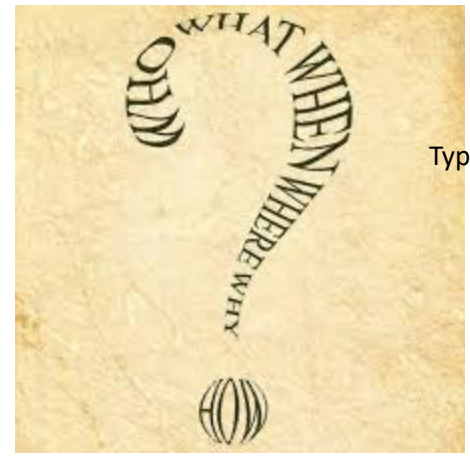
1 ½ cups extra-virgin olive oil  
¾ cup soy sauce  
½ cup red wine vinegar  
½ cup freshly squeezed lemon juice  
¼ cup Worcestershire sauce  
2 garlic cloves, peeled and crushed  
1 ½ teaspoons roughly chopped fresh parsley  
2 tablespoons dry mustard  
2 ¼ teaspoons kosher salt, plus more as needed  
1 teaspoon black pepper, plus more as needed  
1 kilo venison loin or leg,

### PREPARATION

Combine all ingredients except venison in a large bowl. Submerge venison in the marinade, cover with plastic wrap and refrigerate at least 8 hours and up to 12 hours. Heat broiler, stovetop grill pan or grill. Remove venison from marinade and season with salt and pepper. place venison under the broiler or on the grilling surface and cook, flipping once, until medium-rare, 4 to 5 minutes per side. Allow venison to rest for 5 minutes before serving.

Richard's tip: In the States they usually cut it into steaks but I find it much better to cook the venison piece whole until medium-rare and then slice it once it is rested.

A couple of bay leaves and some juniper berries (if you can find them) enhance the marinade.

# Woodbank Bridge Inspections and Repair Update

Repair to the Woodbank Bridge railings will start with scaffold being attached to the sides of the bridge, on 8 March.

The scaffolding area is a working platform with overlapping timber planks. Please respect that it is NOT a safe place to explore or use for a walkway.

Replacement of the bridge railings and kerb will start soon after the scaffold assembly. This work will take approximately two weeks.

Hardwood timber, recycled from the Lyttelton Wharf, is being used for the replacement kerb blocks. These will be more durable than the previous timbers.

The bridge will be closed for the majority of each day while the work takes place. Hours are yet to be confirmed.

The closing times of the bridge will be widely publicised once work dates are confirmed.

Emergency Service vehicles will be able to cross the bridge if needed.

Structural Engineers from WSP have inspected the bridge this week and confirmed that the bridge structure is and has been safe to use in its current state. The piles go deep below the river. There is no concern about strength or structural integrity. The bridge has a remaining life expectancy of 30 years or more. All weight restrictions were removed with the strengthening work in 2020. The bridge is strong enough to carry full HPMV loads. The only limiting factor for the bridge is width between the kerb blocks.

# SPCA wants to reassure Kiwi pet owners how best to care for their companion animals during this uncertain time.

Currently, there is no evidence that companion animals can infect humans with COVID-19 virus, and SPCA urges owners not abandon their pets. If you haven't tested positive or are self-isolating, then continue to interact with your pets as normal but wash hands thoroughly before and after touching them, their food, toys, and bedding.

Your pets may be impacted if you or members of your family test positive for the virus or need to self-isolate. The worst time to try and make arrangements for your pet's care is when you're already sick.

## **SPCA encourages all owners to plan for the care for their pets. This includes:**

- Setting up an arrangement with a friend or family member, pet sitter or boarding facility to provide care should you or someone in your household become ill.
- Making sure your pet is up to date on their vaccinations, in the event boarding becomes necessary.
- Ensuring all your pet's medications are documented with dosages and administering instructions, and a 30-day supply. Including a prescription from your veterinarian is also helpful.
- Ensuring all pets have identification including a collar with their current identification tags and a registered microchip (check to make sure your contact details are up to date!)
- Creating a list of useful contact details such as your vet and pet insurance provider.
- Having two weeks' worth of food, crates and extra supplies on hand. If you're not able to go to the supermarket or vet, ask a friend or neighbour if they can collect items for you, or call and see if delivery options are available.

## **Caring for pets during self-isolation**

If you are sick or under medical attention for COVID-19, arrange for another person to care for your pet if possible. If you are unable to do this, as a precaution you should avoid contact with your pets, including petting, snuggling, being kissed or licked, and sharing food with them.

If your cat normally goes outdoors, it's advised to keep them indoors for people who are self-isolating because:

- They, or someone in their household, has a confirmed COVID-19 infection
- They or someone in their household, has known exposure to someone with a confirmed COVID-19 infection
- They or someone in their household is in an at-risk group (i.e. over 70 years old or with a pre-existing health condition such as chronic respiratory disease - including severe asthma, bronchiectasis and COPD - and those who are immunocompromised)

SPCA has lots of great advice on keeping cats happy and healthy as 'stay at home' felines.

If you are voluntarily self-isolating, you can still take your dog for walks but avoid places where social contact is likely, maintain a 2m distance from other people, don't let people pet your dog and follow good hygiene practices (avoid touching your face and wash your hands after your walk).

You can replace your dog's usual exercise with other activities such as:

- Introducing food puzzles to make mealtimes more interesting
- Playing fetch or tug with your dog
- Teaching them a new trick
- Hide treats around the garden or around the house and send them off in search of them.

If you have any worries about your pet's health during self-isolation, give your vet a call for advice, but don't visit the surgery in person.

These changes mean that:

- ✓ Cases will be identified via a positive PCR or Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) and will need to isolate for 10 days.
- ✓ Household contacts of cases will immediately self-isolate for 10 days at the same time the positive household case is confirmed. They need to get a RAT on day 3 and 10.
- ✓ Close Contacts are no longer required to self-isolate but do need to monitor for symptoms for 10 days and get tested if they become symptomatic.

## The Frustrations of Trying to Get An Answer on the Internet

Dateline 2/2/222

At 9.30 am I contacted the company Dropbox. It is quite common for people to use this service when they want to send a file that's too big for Email. The system works by me sending Dropbox the completed Pinkie which is usually 200 plus megabytes. I then let the printer know and they go to Dropbox and get the file. But it has stopped uploading.

By 1230 I was still on Dropbox's service 'Chat' line and somehow we are yet to really address the problem and I am on my third 'consultant'. I have been through bullshit involving ticket numbers and all sorts of incomprehensible computer gobbledey gook and 'escalation' (a favourite word) to technical experts and upgrade options but not the problem at hand. Not to mention the 'easy listening' music while I am on hold. This is enough to tear your hair out and is designed to make you hang up.

At 1242 a box on my desktop opens up and says we have the answers to your problems, consult us here on *Just Answers*. First give us \$2 to join our service - this is refundable.

1255 an 'expert' in Dropbox problems comes on line and offers to help. After about three minutes I am told I have so far clocked up \$59 in fees, do I want to go any further and will I give the expert, Mr Gupta a rating out of ten. I lose my patience and say if he wants to be paid anything he has to address the problem, I warn that I will get my lawyer involved. 'Ah!' they say "You want a lawyer. We'll get you an expert on the law."

At this stage I think I had better have a look at my online banking and I see *Just Answers* has taken \$2 initial fee to connect, \$70 for a monthly membership, \$59 for the inexpert Mr Gupta, then \$215 for legal expert Mr Ginsborg, who hadn't even made contact, not that I wanted him to. I then contact BNZ and cancelled that card before they take any more, and the BNZ is very helpful.

Back to *Just Answers* and I demand a refund of my money. They send me a form to 'request a refund' and I spend the next three hours on the phone with a particularly snide and nasty woman who keeps putting me on hold. By now it is 8.40 in the evening. In the space for Occupation on the refund form I write 'Chief Justice of the New Zealand Supreme Court' and I also knight myself. Miracle - at 4.40 the following afternoon the money comes back into my account.

Nevertheless, by now, on Friday, after 16 hours in total on the phone have had been elevated to the Senior Technical Adviser with Dropbox (a lady called Pearl Jam (she/her) and I am anticipating that the problem might possibly be fixed next week, although I am still smarting at having been called several disrespectful names, one of them "old".

So far, the most technical solution offered for my problem has been turning my computer off and on again and then we advanced to turning the programme off and on again.

I am currently awaiting another reply from Pearl Jam but I have an inkling she might not call back because I have upset her by asking her how she got her job, if that's all she can offer - the universal tech solution of off and on again.

And the moral is - never give anyone your card number.

And if you have problems with Dropbox - give up.

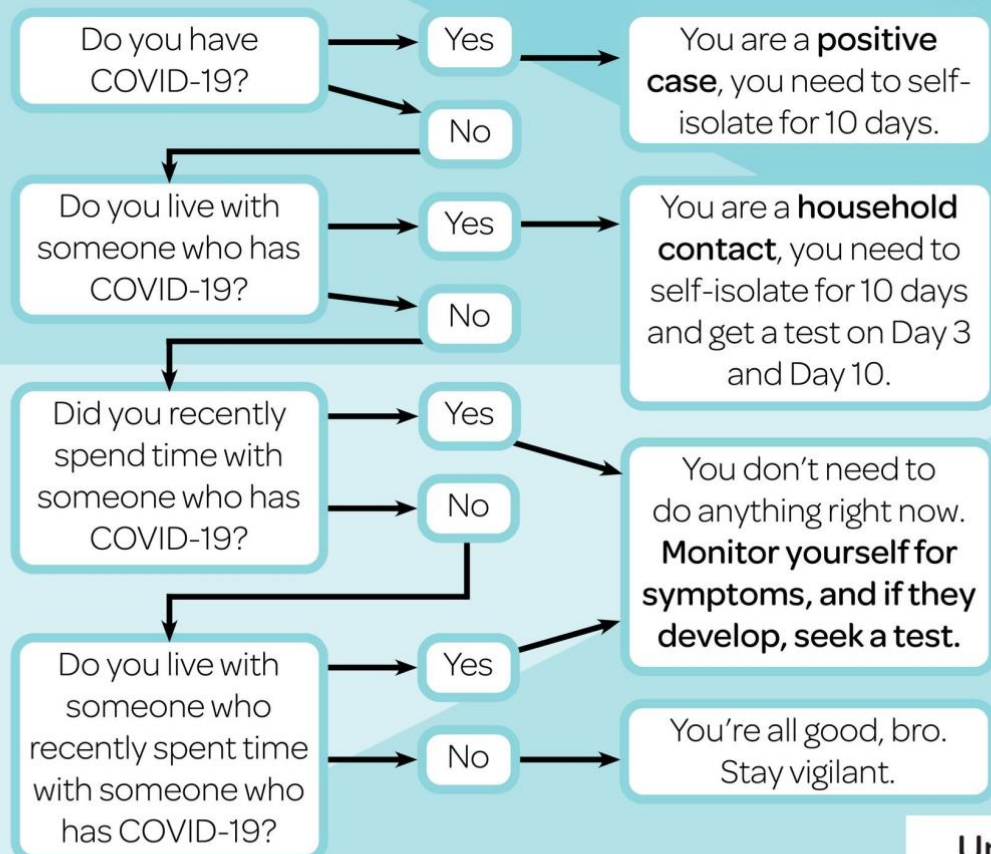
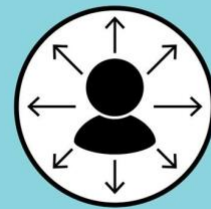

During the Omicron response, workers at registered critical services who are identified as Household Contacts may continue to work if they meet the following criteria:

- be deemed critical by their employer
- work in a critical service. Critical services include:
  - ✓ food production and its supply chain
  - ✓ key public services like health and emergency services
  - ✓ lifeline utilities such as power and water supplies
  - ✓ transport
  - ✓ critical financial services
  - ✓ news media
  - ✓ social welfare
  - ✓ human and animal health and welfare.

Businesses and organisations can self-assess and sign up to the scheme on <https://business.govt.nz>

- be fully vaccinated
- be asymptomatic
- return a negative rapid antigen test unsupervised before each day/shift they work during their isolation period
- follow specific health protocols
- only go to work — they cannot go anywhere else.

Workers should talk to their employer if they think they meet the criteria to be part of the Close Contact Exemption Scheme.

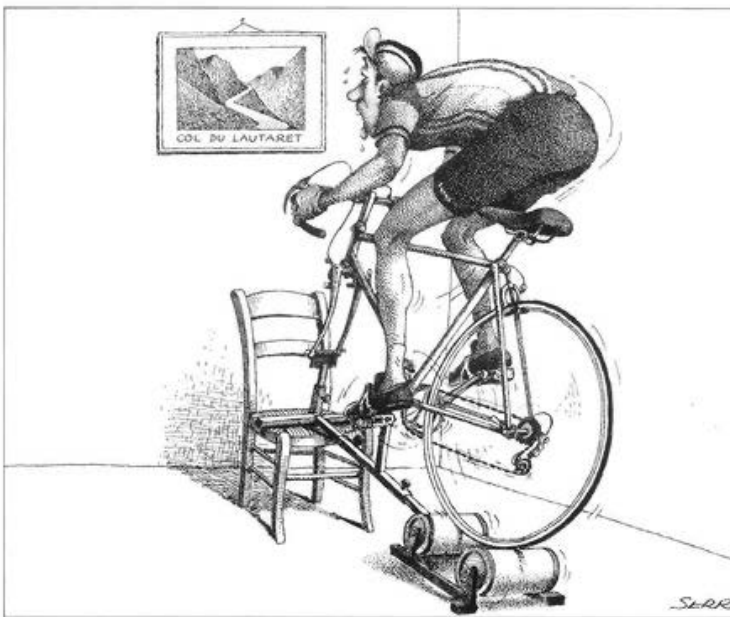
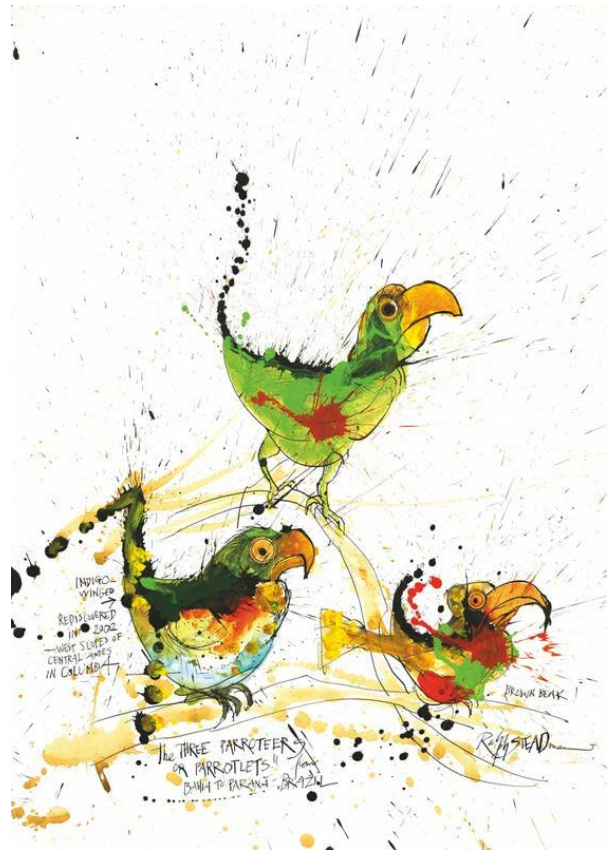

## Know your Plastic Codes as In Hurunui 1, 2 and 5 ONLY can be Recycled

Symbol	Acronym	Full name and uses
	PET	Polyethylene terephthalate - Fizzy drink bottles and frozen ready meal packages.
	HDPE	High-density polyethylene - Milk and washing-up liquid bottles
	PVC	Polyvinyl chloride - Food trays, cling film, bottles for squash, mineral water and shampoo.
	LDPE	Low density polyethylene - Carrier bags and bin liners.
	PP	Polypropylene - Margarine tubs, microwave-able meal trays.
	PS	Polystyrene - Yoghurt pots, foam meat or fish trays, hamburger boxes and egg cartons, vending cups, plastic cutlery, protective packaging for electronic goods and toys.
	Other	Any other plastics that do not fall into any of the above categories. For example melamine, often used in plastic plates and cups.
