# COVID IN THE COMMUNITY UPDATE

Hanmer Springs Health Centre, Sunday 17th April 7pm

We have seen a **40% drop in new positive cases reported over the last week** in our community, compared to the previous week.

We strongly encourage those doing their own Rapid Antigen Testing / isolation to record their results, whether positive or negative by:

1. Going online and recording it at <u>https://my-covidrecord.nz</u>

OR

2. Calling 0800 222 478 and choose option 3

Reminder: If you are a household contact, living with a positive COVID-19 person, you should immediately self-isolate for seven days and not go to work. You should also test for COVID-19 on days 3 and 7 via a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT). We can do this at the Health Centre for you FREE of charge. On completion of 7 days isolation, with no positive RAT results or symptoms, you can return to work on day 8.

# To help **keep yourself well** and **minimise the spread of COVID-19** we encourage you to:

- Stay home if you are unwell or have COVID-19 symptoms.
- Isolate if you are a household contact living with a positive COVID-19 case, to protect you, your family and whanau and the wider community.
- Book a FREE supervised Rapid Antigen Test and short consultation with us if you have symptoms. Simply call our reception team on 03 315 7503.
- Wear a surgical or N95 mask and show your vaccination pass if asked.
- Keep up healthy habits such as washing hands regularly and physical distancing.

Please call us on 03 315 7503, whether you are registered with us or not, if you are feeling unwell or need to see us for any reason. We are here for all our community.

### Getting a COVID-19 vaccine if you've had COVID-19

It's now recommended by the Ministry of Health that you wait 3 months after you test positive for COVID-19 before getting any COVID-19 vaccination. This recommendation is for all ages

and applies to all COVID-19 vaccines available in New Zealand.

Waiting for 3 months after you test positive for COVID-19 can give you better protection and an increased immune response to the vaccine dose



However, you are can still have your FLU vaccination when you have completed your COVID-19 isolation and symptom free

If you call our clinic phone out of hours, your call is always answered by a registered nurse who will assess your needs, offer advice or, if required, pass the call to our on-call clinician. It can take several minutes to answer the phone so please be patient and hold, and follow the voice prompts carefully

# Vegan Thai Curry

Although some Thai curry pastes contain fish or shrimp paste, there are brands which do not.

#### Ingredients

#### 1 x 400ml can coconut milk (do not shake can)

1/2 cup vegetable stock

- 4 teaspoons soy sauce or tamari soy sauce
- 4 teaspoons palm sugar or brown sugar
- 6 tablespoons Thai green curry paste, which has no shrimp or fish paste
- 1/2 cup diced onion
- 2/3 cup diced red capsicum
- 2/3 cup diced courgette
- 2/3 cup diced peeled sweet potato

3 cup sliced bamboo shoots, rinsed and drained

1 cup green beans, trimmed and cut into 2 cm lengths

2/3 cup diced eggplant

- 1 lime
- 8 large basil leaves, cut into thin chiffonade

#### PREPARATION

Open the can of coconut milk without shaking it. Spoon 6 tablespoons of the coconut cream from the top of the can into a medium saucepan. Pour remaining contents of can into a medium bowl, and mix well. In a medium bowl, combine vegetable stock, soy sauce, and palm or brown sugar. Stir until the sugar is dissolved.

Place saucepan of coconut cream over medium-high heat until it begins to bubble. Add curry paste and reduce heat to medium-low. Stir constantly until very fragrant, about 3 minutes; adjust heat as needed to prevent burning. Add onion, red pepper, zucchini, sweet potato, bamboo shoots, green beans, and eggplant. Stir until vegetables are hot, 2-3 minutes. Stir in coconut milk, bring the mixture to a boil, and reduce heat to low. Simmer, uncovered, until the vegetables are tender, about 10 minutes.

Add the soy sauce mixture and a generous squeeze of fresh lime juice to taste; you may use the juice of an entire lime. Stir and mix well. Add up to 1/4 cup water if the curry seems too thick.

To serve, place the curry in a warm serving bowl and garnish with the basil chiffonade. If desired, serve over jasmine rice.

Spiced Chickpea Salad With Tahini and **Pita Chips** INGREDIENTS FOR THE CHICKPEAS: 2 400ml cans chickpeas, well drained, or 4 cups cooked chickpeas 3/4 to 1 cup extra-virgin olive oil 2 garlic cloves, minced 2 teaspoons ground cumin, or 1 teaspoon each ground cumin and ground coriander 1 teaspoon sweet paprika Salt and pepper FOR THE TAHINI SAUCE: <sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> cup tahini Freshly squeezed juice of 1 lemon, plus more to taste 1 garlic clove, minced Warm water, as needed TO FINISH: Olive oil, for cooking About 10 ounces kale, chard or spinach, well washed and thick stems removed 3 cups store-bought or homemade pita chips Handful of roughly chopped flat-leaf parsley Handful of roughly chopped mint 1 large or 2 small cucumbers, peeled and thinly sliced Lemon, cut into wedges PREPARATION

Make the chickpeas: Heat oven to 425 degrees. Pour the chickpeas into a small baking dish, about 6 inches by 8 inches. The chickpeas should be crowded together in a thick layer, not spread out. Pour in olive oil just until chickpeas are covered. (This will look like a lot, but don't worry: It forms part of the dressing.)

Add garlic, cumin, paprika, and 2 big pinches each of salt and pepper. Stir gently to combine. Bake until oil is bubbling around the chickpeas and they are turning reddish-brown, 35 to 40 minutes. Set aside to cool.

Meanwhile, make tahini sauce: Pour tahini into a bowl and whisk in lemon juice and garlic. The tahini will thicken and clump. Slowly whisk in warm water, 1 tablespoon at a time, until sauce becomes smooth, creamy and pourable. Taste and season with salt, pepper and more lemon juice, if desired. Set aside.

Cook the greens: Place a large frying pan over medium heat and drizzle lightly with olive oil. When hot, add the greens in batches, along with a big pinch of salt. Stir until wilted and tender and set aside.

When ready to serve, in a large bowl, gently mix chickpeas and their cooking oil with the cooked greens, half the pita chips, and the chopped herbs. Mound chickpea mixture in 4 shallow bowls. Divide cucumber slices around chickpeas. Drizzle thickly with half the tahini sauce and scatter remaining pita chips on top. Place a lemon wedge on the side and serve, passing extra tahini sauce at the table.





## Good Connections Creates Good Health

Tsarina Dellow, Hurunui District Council's TLA Community Representative for Waitaha Primary Health needs little introduction to people in Hanmer Springs having been a resident here for many years.

She is a Chartered Accountant, with a background in the medical sector too. She previously worked in administration at Hanmer Springs Health Centres and was also a local St John volunteer. Tsarina acknowledges there are different health challenges and needs for rural and urban people, and different expectations. For example, the waiting time in a rural practice can be longer when an emergency case comes in, as rural clinics act as emergency centres too.

"With the trend of urban and city people moving out to guieter areas like Hanmer Springs, dealing with differences like this comes down to education, and managing people's expectations." With a financial background, Tsarina is a Director at Shore Accounting Solutions in Amberley and is a Trustee of Community Wellbeing North Canterbury Trust and Compass FM boards.

She believes that in a rural area like Hanmer Springs lies a big importance on community connections and letting people know there is support out there across all health areas.

"We need to work together on issues that come up, whether that be access to health facilities, or helping people with COVID-19 concerns or queries.

"Waitaha Primary Health's focus 'Your health, your whānau, our community' is to provide and support health services in Canterbury's rural and urban communities, and Tsarina is excited about being a Board member and part of this."I care a lot about Primary health care, particularly in North Canterbury's rural sector."

As a Board member, Tsarina will be working closely with General Practices and other community based health providers, with the aim of delivering exceptional health outcomes for Canterbury's people, including those with the greatest need."It's all about connection, because this is what makes communities and allows people to enjoy their best life with good health and wellbeing. It's about us all getting out and doing our bit."

Hurunui Mayor Marie Black is thrilled to have Tsarina represent the District on the Waitaha Board, with her many transferable skills that will bring value to the organisation.

"She will be a strong health advocate for the Hurunui District," said Mayor Black.

# Visit Hurunui invites the community to have a yarn about the District's future

"Are there any areas in the district that we're not utilising to their full potential?" Scotty Bamford asks, to which he receives a response of stunned silence.

Standing on the edge of a cliff on his Hurunui Hills farm, Scotty is calling out to a flock of sheep below. For obvious reasons, none of his flock are willing to have a yarn.

The comedy is part of Visit Hurunui's new initiative, Let's have a yarn, which is calling on the public to guide the future of tourism in the region – or risk letting those of the four-legged variety decide.

Visit Hurunui have launched Let's have a yarn to help guide the creation of the region's destination management plan (DMP). Through the campaign, the community are being encouraged to submit feedback online or join one of the various in-person sessions being held in the community. The feedback gathered will provide Visit Hurunui with ideas and inspiration to better meet the needs of both visitors and residents.

Visit Hurunui marketing manager Shane Adcock says the DMP is essential to creating a future for tourism, which benefits everyone.

"Visitor numbers to New Zealand were growing at an unprecedented rate prior to the pandemic. As a country we were facing some real challenges because of this. In Hurunui, we were just starting to feel the impact of that growth so we now have a chance to plan ahead and ensure that tourism can grow alongside our communities. The DMP is about bringing everyone together to find out what we can be doing better to create an epic visitor experience that benefits our communities in every sense, while taking us into this new era of tourism."

In the Let's have a yarn videos, Hurunui farmer, Scotty Bamford interviews 'local talent' at three identifiable locations, including the Hurunui rugby grounds, a playcentre group and his own farm called Hurunui Hills, to highlight the need for the public to get their voice out there.

In one video Scotty is hollering to his sheep, asking them what their dreams are for development, while in another, he stands alone in the middle of the Hurunui Rugby Club grounds interviewing a rugby tackle pad to awkward silence.

Hanmer Springs playcentre members, Eliza, Hazel and Myra are perhaps the real stars of the show.

"What do you love about Hanmer Springs and the Hurunui region?" Scotty asks Myra.

"The moon," answers the three year-old.

Shane says the short videos draw on humour to break up an otherwise fairly serious subject.

"We really want our communities across Hurunui to have a yarn with us in person, but if they can't make one of the drop-in sessions, they can spin their own online. We've made this really accessible because we do want this to be a DMP reflective of our communities," says Shane.

# Hurunui Council Not Considering Regulation of Short-term Home Rentals

Some New Zealand Councils, including Auckland, Christchurch and Queenstown have introduced new regulations for short term housing rentals and Airbnb type letting arrangements.

New rules have drawn a lot of protest and possibly court appeals for new laws which have been described by some as as "restrictive and outdated".

In these areas people who are renting out properties as unhosted visitor accommodation face a new situation.

For example, the Christchurch regulations mean a consent would have to be obtained for houses rented out.Similar rules are to be applied in Auckland and Queenstown with consent costing around \$1000.

Because of the amount of unhosted visitor accommodation in Hanmer Springs The Pinkie contacted the Hurunui District Council to see if they were considering similar regulation of this market.

Hurunui Council CEO, Hamish Dobbie, has advised us "HDC has not considered introducing new rules for short term rentals and is of the view that the rental markets in Queenstown, Christchurch and Auckland are considerably different to those in Hanmer Springs."
