If you **perform your own Rapid Antigen Test (RAT)** for COVID-19, you should **record your results, whether positive or negative**, by:

If you are **living with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19** you also **need to isolate** and have a **Rapid Antigen Test (RAT)** for COVID-19 on **days 3 and 7** of your isolation.

**FLU AND COVID-19
VACCINATION CLINICS**

We have walk-in **FLU** and **COVID-19** Clinics this week as follows:

- **Wednesday 1st June 2.30pm–4pm at the rear car park of Hanmer Springs Health Centre, for age 5-11 and 12+**



Pregnant and COVID 19?

After you have recovered: After you have recovered from COVID-19 and have finished isolation your LMC will continue to provide your regular check-ups before and after your baby is born. If you had mild or no symptoms, you will continue to receive normal care from your LMC.

Vaccination after recovery: If you were not vaccinated before you caught COVID-19, you can have your 1st or 2nd vaccination, or you can have the booster three months after you have recovered.

Will my baby get COVID-19? If your baby catches COVID-19, it is likely they will be mildly unwell or have no symptoms. To help protect your baby from catching COVID-19:

1. **Make sure that you wash your hands with soap & water for 20 seconds before you touch your baby.**
2. **Wear a mask when within 2 metres of your baby, eg when breastfeeding.**
3. **Wear a mask for 7 days from when you started to have symptoms.**

If you are worried that your baby is unwell, contact your LMC or family doctor for advice.

Can I breastfeed if I have COVID? Yes, breastfeeding your baby is recommended even if you have COVID-19. There are antibodies in your breastmilk that will help protect your baby from COVID-19. You can get breastfeeding & infant feeding support from your LMC.

Feeling anxious & stressed about COVID-19? It is normal to feel anxious, upset, worried or stressed about COVID-19:

1. **You can talk to your LMC or family doctor**
2. **If you feel very worried or upset & want to talk to someone you can call 0800 111 757 or text 4202 for free anytime to speak to a trained counsellor.**

My Vaccine Pass updated

An updated My Vaccine Pass is now available for anyone aged 12 and over who is up-to-date with their COVID-19 vaccinations, as well as for those with a temporary medical exemption. You can now download a new My Vaccine Pass through My Covid Record: <https://mycovidrecord.health.nz/>

If you call our clinic phone out of hours, your call is always answered by a registered nurse who will assess your needs, offer advice or, if required, pass the call to our on-call clinician. It can take several minutes to answer the phone so please be patient and hold, and follow the voice prompts carefully

Pork belly and potato yellow curry with green beans

Ingredients

800g rindless, boneless pork belly, cut into 2cm pieces

800g small potatoes, halved

¼ cup quality yellow curry paste

1 tbsp tamarind paste

2 garlic cloves, crushed

¼ cup coconut sugar

400ml can coconut milk

4 kaffir lime lime leaves

4 sprigs pickled peppercorns

steamed rice, to serve

300g green beans, blanched, to serve

Method

1. Preheat the oven to 200C fan-forced (220C conventional). Place the pork belly and potatoes in a lightly greased deep roasting tray. Season with salt and pepper and roast for 15 minutes.

2. Add the curry paste, tamarind, coconut sugar, coconut milk, lime leaves and peppercorns and mix to combine. Return to the oven and roast for a further 15 minutes.

3. Serve with beans and rice.

Malaysian spicy peanut seafood curry

A fast and easy to throw together seafood curry that feels a little bit luxurious with the inclusion of a quality marinara mix and maybe a few extra prawns

Ingredients

2 shallots, chopped

1 lemongrass stalk, white part only, chopped

4 garlic cloves

¼ cup crunchy peanut butter

2 tbsp kecap manis

2 tbsp sambal oelek

2 tbsp fish sauce

400ml can coconut milk

600g quality marinara mix (mixed fresh seafood and shellfish)

steamed jasmine rice, to serve

baby mint and purple shiso leaves, to serve (optional)

Method

1. Pulse the shallot, lemongrass and garlic in a small food processor to a fine paste.

2. Heat oil in a large wok or frying pan over high heat. Add the paste and cook for 3 minutes, or until fragrant. Add the peanut butter, kecap manis, sambal oelek, fish sauce, coconut milk and 1 cup water. Bring to a simmer and cook for 4 minutes.

3. Add the seafood and cook, turning occasionally, until the seafood is just cooked.

4. Serve with rice and baby herbs, if using.

Pools News

The Pinkie met up with Graeme Abbot last week for a quick report on how things are progressing at the Pools and Spa complex.

Graeme told us that things are getting back to normal after more than a few diversions and interruptions. He told us they are happy that they had a good month in April with numbers through the door at 80% of the average for that time of the year.

"We are back up and running," he said, "Which is exciting for everyone concerned. January ran at about 75%, but February and March followed the trend of the rest of the village in that we were down to around 50% of what we would normally expect. So we were more than delighted with our April figures heading back in the right direction."

In other Pools news, there is going to be some work happening with some repair and maintenance work on the original slide. Apparently, now that the cost of the slides is incorporated in the price of admission there has been a marked increase in the number of adults using them.

The Pools are also teaming up with TOITU in order to accurately assess carbon footprint and to manage and reduce environmental impact. Toitū Envirocare's new **Toitū carbon assess** platform enables enterprises to collate and track the combined carbon emissions of their day to day business

	HDPE	High-density polyethylene - Milk and washing-up liquid bottles
	PVC	Polyvinyl chloride - Food trays, cling film, bottles for squash, mineral water and shampoo.
	LDPE	Low density polyethylene - Carrier bags and bin liners.
	PP	Polypropylene - Margarine tubs, microwave-able meal trays.

Out of hours recycling facilities for paper, card, cans, plastics types 1, 2 & 5 only and glass bottles are provided; please ensure recycling is clean, loose and all lids are removed. Soft plastics (i.e. those you can scrunch in your hand) are not recyclable and must be placed in the refuse.

Kerbside refuse and recycling collection – Monday 8am

Only official refuse and recycling bags will be collected; these can be purchased from Hanmer Springs Service Station and the library and the Log Cabin & Super Liquor. Via the recycling bags clean paper, card, cans and plastics types 1, 2 & 5 only can be recycled.

If in doubt – place it in the refuse to save contaminating recycling.

Non complying bags and recycling bags containing glass and soft plastics will not be collected.

Please Note that HDC garbage & recycling bags are no longer available from the Four Square supermarket. Henceforth, bags will only be available from Hanmer Springs Service Station, the library, The Log Cabin and Super Liquor

The Council provided household glass recycling boxes are for clean glass bottles and jars only with all lids removed.
All other recycling must be placed into a Council recycling bag for collection.

Queen's Birthday Refuse and Recycling Arrangements

During the week commencing June 6, refuse and recycling in Hanmer Springs will be collected one day later than normal, on Tuesday 7 June.

Please place official Hurunui District Council rubbish and recycling bags at the kerbside boundary of the property by 8am for collection.

Household glass bottles will be collected in Hanmer Springs providing they are in an official Council recycling box; all lids are removed, and the boxes are not overloaded or contain other types of recycling.

Excess glass bottles can be recycled via the Council's transfer stations during opening hours.

Rubbish bags will not be collected for the following reasons:

- An official Hurunui Council bag has not been used.
- The bag exceeds the allowable 15kg weight or is not securely tied.
- The bag contains something which could endanger the collector or damage the vehicle e.g. medical or hazardous waste, needles, animal waste, ashes, sharp objects, or liquids.
- The bag is full of bottles or contains unwrapped glass.
