## COVID IN THE COMMUNITY UPDATE

Hanmer Springs Health Centre,  
Sunday 14th August

The Pinkie has not received a report the number of newly recorded COVID-19 positive cases in the community for last week.

Let's continue to stay well this winter and help protect each other by:

- **Booking our COVID-19 2<sup>nd</sup> Booster shots** and/or our **tamariki for their 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> COVID-19 vaccination** by calling/txting **020 4091 0704**. Next clinic Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> August.
- Getting up to date with our *vaccinations for flu, and measles*. Reminder –Tamariki aged 3-12yrs are eligible for a FREE flu vaccination.
- *Wearing a mask indoors* whenever we are not at home.
- *Staying home if we are unwell* and test for COVID-19 using a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) yourself or book an appointment with the Health Centre to be tested.
- Calling our reception team on 03 315 7503 if you have COVID-19 symptoms or feeling unwell.

- ✓ Māori and Pacific Peoples older than 50
- ✓ People who are severely immunocompromised
- ✓ Health, aged-care and disability workers over the age of 30.

**NOTE: A minimum of 6 months after your first booster must have passed before you can have the second. (or three months post Covid-19 infection whichever is the later date)**

# Council and Community Board Elections For Hanmer Springs

## Mayor, Ward Councillors and Community Board Nominees All Elected Unopposed

Hanmer Springs residents will not have to make any choices for the forthcoming Local Body elections as all the nominees for Mayor, West Ward Councillors and the Community Board are elected unopposed


Congratulations to Mayor Marie Black who is elected for a second term as Mayor of Hurunui District. Her first term was certainly not the easiest of times which encompassed Covid, lockdowns, traffic light systems and a challenge to the Three Waters legislation plus some severe weather events. Let's hope that we don't have to cope with another three years as tumultuous as the past.

With the resignation of Mary Holloway and Nicky Anderson from their Councillor positions in the West Ward, two new Councillors were needed to fill these positions. Both new nominees will now join incumbents, Karen Armstrong and Ross Barnes. New councillors will be David Hislop and Hanmer Springs resident, Tom Davies.

For the Hanmer Springs Community Board, four of the incumbent members, Mary Holloway, Chris Hughey, Alice Stielow and Michael Malthus have again been nominated with the fifth position being filled by Richard Tapper.

Although Hanmer Springs is now a part of the West ward and no longer has its own Councillor, we have been fortunate in having a Hanmer resident elected to become an almost de facto councillor for the town.

This year is no different Hanmer Springs resident Tom Davies being elected to fill Mary Holloway's shoes (although Mary has stayed with the Community Board).

## ALLEGED LAX DISCIPLINE.

[BY TELEGRAPH.—SPECIAL TO THE POST.]

CHRISTCHURCH, This Day.

Some trouble has arisen at the prison camp at Hanmer. It is stated that the discipline is exceedingly lax, and some of the prisoners have got out of hand. The foresters engaged in the tree-planting are supposed to assist the warders in maintaining discipline, but they seem to have been disinclined to do this. It is reported that some of the prisoners have attended public gatherings, and that they have been photographed in public places, in company with warders. The position is regarded as rather serious. It is expected that Mr. W. C. Kensington, Under-Secretary for Lands, will arrive from Wellington to-morrow, and will go to Hanmer, and that Mr. H. W. Bishop, S.M., will also visit the plantation to-morrow to hold an enquiry.

"As far as my information goes, and I have made enquiries," said the Minister for Justice (Hon. Dr. Findlay) to a Post reporter, "the statements in the telegram are fanciful and exaggerated. Some trouble has arisen in connection with the conduct of one of the warders, and there is some conflict as to the actual facts. I have asked Mr. Bishop, S.M. at Christchurch, to proceed to Hanmer and make a short enquiry and furnish me with a report."





## Green Curry Glazed Tofu

### INGREDIENTS

- 1 (500 gram) block extra-firm tofu
- Sea salt
- 1 (400ml) can full-fat, unsweetened coconut milk
- 3 to 4 tablespoons Thai green curry paste
- 1 tablespoon neutral or coconut oil, plus more as needed
- 2 cups chopped vegetables, such as snap or snow peas, asparagus, broccoli, kale, fennel or corn kernels or a combination
- 2 tablespoons lime juice (from 1 lime)
- Cooked rice or another grain, for serving

### PREPARATION

Transfer the coconut milk to a liquid measuring cup or medium bowl, add the green curry paste, stir with a fork until smooth, then season to taste with salt. (Be aware that some curry pastes are quite salty.) Arrange the tofu in an even layer in a large (30cm) nonstick or well-seasoned cast-iron skillet. Pour 2 tablespoons coconut-curry mixture over the tofu and flip the tofu to coat. Set the skillet over medium-high and cook tofu without flipping until the skillet is dry and the undersides of the tofu are speckled golden, 3 to 5 minutes. Add the oil, swirl to coat, then flip the tofu. Cook until browned and crisp, 3 to 5 minutes, then flip once more until the remaining side is browned and crisp, 1 to 2 minutes, adding additional oil as needed. Transfer to a plate. If the skillet is dry, add more oil, over medium-high, then add the vegetables, season with salt, and cook, without stirring, until charred underneath, 2 to 3 minutes. Pour in the remaining coconut-curry mixture and boil, stirring occasionally, until the vegetables are crisp-tender and the liquid has thickened to a glaze, 4 to 5 minutes. (The sauce is ready when a spoon dragged across the bottom of the skillet leaves a trail.) Turn off the heat, stir in the lime juice, then add the tofu and gently stir to coat. Season to taste with salt. Eat on top of rice.

## Cumin-Roasted Salmon With Coriander Sauce

### INGREDIENTS

#### FOR THE SAUCE:

- 1 cup coriander, leaves and tender stems, chopped
- ¼ cup finely chopped chives (from about 1/2 bunch)
- 1 garlic clove, very finely chopped
- 1 tablespoon distilled white vinegar
- ¼ cup olive oil
- salt and black pepper

#### FOR THE SALMON:

- 1 ¾ teaspoons freshly ground cumin
- ½ teaspoon smoked paprika
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- salt and ground black pepper
- 750 gram skin-on salmon fillet
- 1 lemon, cut into wedges, for serving

### PREPARATION

Make the sauce: Combine coriander, chives, garlic, vinegar and olive oil in a medium bowl. (Alternatively, pulse the ingredients in a food processor until you've reached the desired consistency.) Season with salt and pepper, and set aside.

Roast the salmon: Heat oven to 180 degrees. Combine cumin, paprika and olive oil in a small bowl, and season with salt and pepper. Season salmon with salt and pepper and place in a baking dish or on a rimmed baking sheet. Drizzle salmon with spiced olive oil mixture, transfer to the oven, and roast until fish is opaque and just cooked through, 15 to 18 minutes. Remove salmon from oven and spoon coriander-sauce over the top. Serve with lemon wedges on the side.



All projects must have an arts focus, begin after 28 September 2022 and be completed before 28 September 2023.

# Hanmer Springs - A Deep Dive

## From The Perspective of a New Permanent Resident of Three months Who Has Had a Bach in the Village for 32 Years

1. A one-way bridge to get in - this would be a good place for a toll - say \$1 per crossing - either way.
2. Once you get in, only two shingle roads to otherwise get out and even they are closed most of the year (really - there is only one sealed road in and one sealed road out).
3. Annual rainfall: 1066mm to 1220mm (42 - 48 inches)
4. Height above sea level (at Boulder Point) 372 metres (1221 feet)
5. Thermal pools - one complex - international - with many pools
6. Motels and accommodation: 42
7. Retail shops: 22
8. Eating establishments: 29
9. Activities to do: 14
10. Art galleries: 4
11. Library: 1
12. Forest walks: 7
13. Cycle tracks: 12
14. Mini golf: 2
15. Golf course: 1
16. Picture theatre: 0
17. Town and area toilets: 8
18. Public car parking facilities: 7
19. Petrol stations: 1
20. Garages: 2
21. Banks 1/4
22. Medical Centre: 1 (Doctor 3 days a week)
23. Solicitors : 0
24. Justices of the Peace :5
25. High Schools: 0
26. Primary schools: 1 (Current school roll: 96 students- which is unchanged for 40 years)
27. Permanent population: 800-900
28. Permanent population 40 years ago: 1200
29. Number of residential houses in the valley: approximately 1,020
30. Number of bachs, houses available to be rented out - approximately 600 (a number though are not rented out)
31. Number of houses lived in by permanent residents: approximately 420
32. Possible Hanmer average residential property value: say \$650,000 - \$750,000
33. Maybe annual average overall Hanmer house mortgage - say \$200,000 to \$300,000
34. If there are 600 bach/house owners, then probably of these say 500 (most of them) will own another house in Christchurch or elsewhere.
35. When you stand back and think about this data and you take the view that 1,000 residents is a small New Zealand town/village, then Hanmer Springs is perhaps, along with Akaroa, the wealthiest two small towns in the South Island and maybe in New Zealand. (Akaroa's house and population data is similar to Hanmer Springs.)

### ***How Do I Arrive at this conclusion:***


(a). Let's say, that of the 800-900 permanent Hanmer Springs residents, that at least 20 of them have a net equity in their house in excess of \$1,000,000 (that is 20 millionaires)

(b) Let's say there are 600 bach/house owners in Hanmer Springs, most of whom rent out their bach and who, in the main, own two houses. Let's say 250 (40%) of them have a confirmed net equity in these two houses, after mortgages, in excess of \$1,000,000 = 250 millionaires

(c) So I am suggesting that Hanmer Springs has 20 permanent millionaires who own a house here and 250 millionaires who are here for some of the time - all of whom support Hanmer in one way or another.

36. All of this will have no effect on a day-to-day basis, but is interesting nevertheless.


