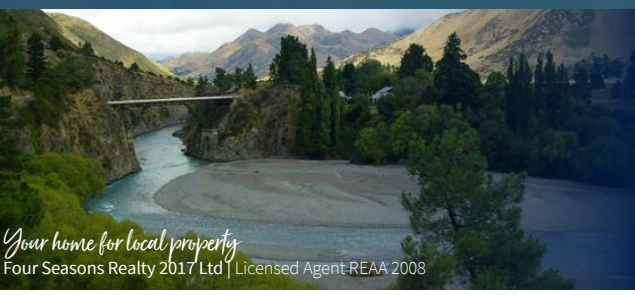

Hanmer Springs Health Centre,
Sunday 7th August 3.45pm

We are pleased to report the number of newly recorded COVID-19 positive cases in the community remains low and similar to last week.

This is great news and let's continue to stay well this winter and help protect each other by:

- Booking our **COVID-19 2nd Booster shots** and/or our **tamariki for their 1st/2nd COVID-19 vaccination** by calling/txting **020 4091 0704**. Next clinic Wednesday 10th August.
- Getting up to date with our *vaccinations for flu, and measles*. Reminder –Tamariki aged 3-12yrs are eligible for a FREE flu vaccination.
- Wearing a mask indoors whenever we are not at home.
- Staying home if we are unwell and test for COVID-19 using a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) yourself or book an appointment with the Health Centre to be tested.
- Calling our reception team on 03 315 7503 if you have COVID-19 symptoms or feeling unwell.

- ✓ People who are severely immunocompromised
- ✓ Health, aged-care and disability workers over the age of 30.

NOTE: A minimum of 6 months after your first booster must have passed before you can have the second. (or three months post Covid-19 infection whichever is the later date)

A Call for Care

So often we read articles on Hamer Springs and especially about the situation with Queen Mary Hospital which are not properly researched nor completely accurate.

North and South magazine and their writer, Sally Blundell are to be commended for the excellent article in the latest issue of the magazine. It is well-written and factual, with Ms Blundell having consulted with and interviewed the people who were informed enough and qualified to tackle the subject. Of particular value were the contributions from Rosemary Ensor and from Hamish Dobbie, CEO of the Hurunui District Council.

It is a shame that Robert Crawford is not here because much of what is said in the article is in line with Robert's call for the continuation of the hospital and its services. The article not only outlines much of the hospital's history but goes into detail on the many efforts that have been made to make something of what remains. Its is recommended reading.

Chicken tenders with smoky BBQ sauce

Frying the breadcrumbs before coating gives these oven-baked chicken tenders a deep-fried taste without the oil and mess. You can also air-fry these if you prefer.

Ingredients

2 tbsp vegetable oil
2 cups panko breadcrumbs
1 egg
2 tbsp mayonnaise
2 tbsp plain flour
1 tsp paprika
½ tsp mild curry powder
½ tsp salt
500g chicken tenderloins

Smoky barbecue nugget sauce

½ cup tomato sauce
1 tbsp Worcestershire sauce
1 tbsp honey
1 tbsp malt vinegar
1 tbsp American mustard
1 tsp smoked paprika

Method

1. Heat your oven to 200C fan-forced (220C conventional). Heat a small frypan over medium heat and add the oil. Toast the breadcrumbs for about 3 minutes until lightly golden and transfer to a plate or tray.

2. Combine the egg, mayonnaise, flour, paprika, curry powder and salt and mix to form a thick batter. Coat the chicken tenderloins in the batter and dredge in the breadcrumbs. Shake off any excess and place the chicken on a wire rack or baking tray lined with baking paper. Bake for 15 minutes, turning once. Serve with the dipping sauce.

Richard's tip Curry powder is a great all-purpose seasoning. Using just a little can add a great depth of flavour without giving a dish a heavily spiced "curry" flavour. I tend to use more than this recipe prescribes (and hotter).

Chez Panisse's Blueberry Cobbler

This cobbler, which comes from the kitchens of Chez Panisse, prizes the berries above all, using only 1/3 cup of sugar. The dough rounds for the top are placed so they don't cover all the berries, and the juice from the berries bubbles up around the dough.

INGREDIENTS

THE BERRIES:

4 ½ cups fresh blueberries (you can use frozen)
⅓ cup sugar

1 tablespoon plain flour

THE DOUGH:

1 ½ cups plain flour

½ teaspoon salt

1 ½ tablespoons sugar

2¼ teaspoons baking powder

6 tablespoons cold unsalted butter, cut into 1 cm pieces

¾ cup heavy cream, plus additional for serving, if desired

PREPARATION

Heat the oven to 375 degrees. To prepare the berries, place in a bowl and toss with the sugar and flour. Set aside.

To make the dough, mix the flour, salt, sugar and baking powder in a bowl. Cut in the butter until mixture resembles coarse meal. Add the cream and mix lightly, just until the dry ingredients are moistened.

Put the blueberries in a baking dish. Make patties out of the dough, 5 to 6 cm in diameter and 1 to 2 cm thick. Arrange them over the top of the berries. Bake until the topping is brown and the juices bubble thickly around it, about 35 to 40 minutes. Let cool slightly. Serve warm, with cream to pour on top, if desired.



There are three funding criteria under the Creative Communities Fund –

Access and Participation - performances by community choirs, hip-hop groups, theatre companies or poets; workshops on painting, sketching, printmaking, writing or dancing etc; exhibitions by local craft groups, festivals featuring local artists; creation of a film or public artwork; development of new tukutuku whakairo or kowhaiwhai for a local marae; artist residencies involving local artists or communities; seminars for the development of local artists.

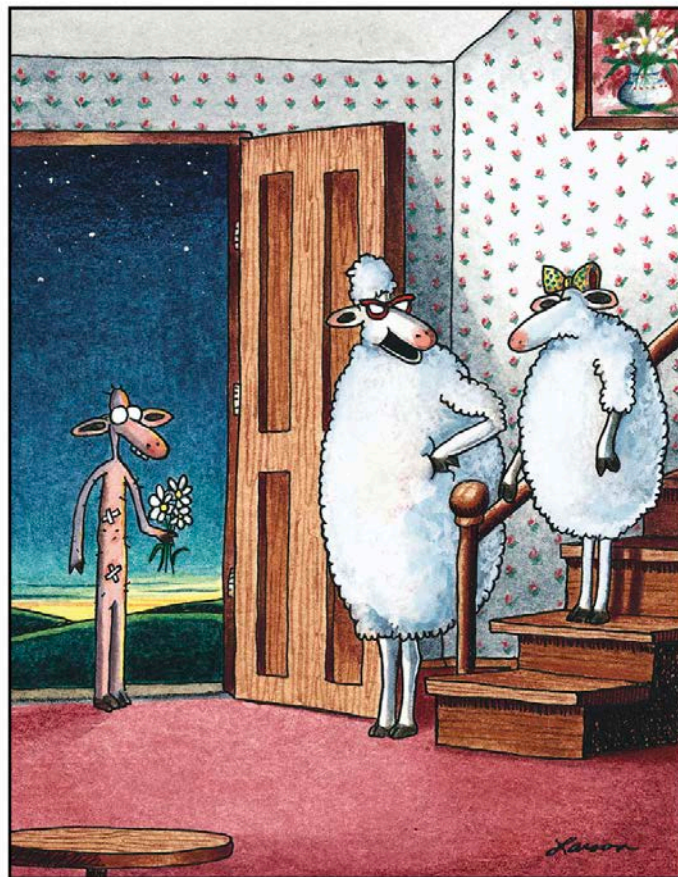


