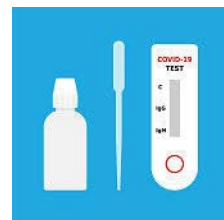

**COVID INFORMATION**

Household contacts should undertake further RAT testing if symptoms develop.

# Grandmother's Good Old Pot Roast

## Ingredients

3 pound boneless beef chuck roast  
 salt and ground black pepper  
 3 tablespoons canola oil  
 4 tablespoons butter  
 2 medium red onions, cut into quarters  
 4 carrots, peeled and cut into 5cm pieces  
 3 stalks celery, cut into 5cm pieces  
 1 swede, peeled and cut into 12 to 16 pieces, about 500 grams  
 8 button mushrooms, halved  
 2 parsnips, peeled and cut into 5 cm pieces  
 1 head garlic, top cut off to expose cloves  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  cup tomato paste  
 2 bay leaves  
 3 sprigs rosemary  
 1½ cups red wine, preferably cabernet  
 4 cups beef broth

## Preparation

*Step 1* Preheat oven to 180 degrees C. Season meat generously with salt and pepper. On the stove top, heat oil in a large Dutch oven, or other heavy roasting pan with a lid, over medium-high heat. Sear the meat until a dark crust forms, 3 to 4 minutes per side. Remove meat to a plate.  
*Step 2* Reduce heat to medium and add butter to the pan. Melt the butter and add the whole head of garlic and vegetables, stirring frequently and scraping the bottom of the pot, until the vegetables start to colour, 8 to 10 minutes.  
*Step 3* Add tomato paste and cook, stirring frequently, until it darkens slightly, about 5 minutes.  
*Step 4* Add bay leaves, rosemary and wine and cook, stirring occasionally, until liquid is reduced to a thick gravy consistency, 5 to 7 minutes.

*Step 5* Return meat to the pot. Add broth, then cover the pot and transfer to the oven. Cook for 2 hours 20 minutes.

*Step 6.* Let roast sit at room temperature for at least 10 minutes. Remove meat to a cutting board to slice. Discard bay leaves and rosemary stems. Squeeze any garlic cloves remaining in their skins into the stew and discard the skins. Serve slices of meat in shallow bowls along with the vegetables and a generous amount of cooking liquid ladled over top.

# French Onion Soup

## Ingredients

3 tablespoons unsalted butter  
 3 to 4 large red or yellow onions (about 1.5 kg), peeled and thinly sliced  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  teaspoon sea salt, more to taste  
 2 litres beef stock  
 1 cup dry white wine  
 1 tablespoon dry sherry  
 1 tablespoon all-purpose flour  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon black pepper, more to taste  
 French bread cut into 8 to 12 1cm slices  
 1½ cups grated Gruyère cheese

## Preparation

*Step 1*  
 Melt butter in a heavy Dutch oven over medium heat. Add onions and  $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon salt, stir and cover, letting onions soften for 5 minutes. Remove lid and let onions caramelize until golden brown over medium heat, stirring occasionally. Adjust heat if onions are browning too quickly. The caramelisation process may take 45 to 60 minutes.  
*Step 2*  
 Meanwhile, warm broth in a saucepan over low heat.  
*Step 3*  
 Once onions are caramelised, add wine and sherry to the pot and allow mixture to come to boil. Stir in flour and let thicken for a minute or two.  
*Step 4*  
 Slowly add warm broth,  $\frac{1}{4}$  teaspoon salt and the pepper to the onion mixture and boil uncovered for 10 minutes. Add more salt and pepper to taste.  
*Step 5*  
 Heat the broiler, and arrange individual ovenproof casseroles on a baking sheet. Ladle soup into casseroles, and cover top with bread slices. Sprinkle each casserole generously with Gruyère. Broil for a minute or two, watching carefully, until cheese melts and browns. Serve immediately.

Not all of these costs may apply in some cases, but the core total is interesting - in summary, it is suggesting:

That our 20-handicapper would average around 92 strokes per round, and a total of 4,784 strokes per year (52 x 92).

This then suggests that the total cost comes out at \$1.82 per stroke, or \$167 per round. This golfer, though, is a happy golfer and looks forward to every weekend.
